## You can enter one or more of the following categories:

### 1. Best Technology Development of Energy Harvesting.

This award will be given to a company which has launched a new product based on energy harvesting (in the last 24 months, May 2008 - May 2010) and is in the process of bringing it to market. The category will be assessed on the technical development of the product, its potential market, and benefits it brings over alternatives.

### 2. Best Application of Energy Harvesting.

This is the award given to an actual commercial success with an end-product using energy harvesting (in the last 24 months, May 2008 – May 2010). Judges will look for success in terms of products sold and revenues generated.

### 3. Best Technology Development of RTLS/WSN.

This award will be given to a company which has launched a new product based on RTLS or WSN technology (in the last 24 months, May 2008 – May 2010) and is in the process of bringing it to market. The category will be assessed on the technical development of the product, its potential market, and benefits it brings over alternatives.

### 4. Best Application of WSN.

This award is given to the best implementation of WSN. In particular, judges are looking to see the payback from the system, how problems were overcome (if any), and benefits to the user.

### 5. Best Application of Active RFID/RTLS.

This award is given to the best implementation of Active RFID (including RTLS) technology (in the last 24 months, May 2008 - May 2010). Here judges will look at the payback and value for the user that implemented the system and how the company overcame hurdles in implementing the technology.
